The LCSD Board of Trustees has a new chair and vice chair. Mary Anne Penner will be leading the board into the 2022-23 school year as chairperson, while Trustee Vicky Lefebvre will step into Mary Anne's former role as vice chair.

BOARD APPROVES CREE COURSES

LCSD students attending high school in Lac La Biche, Cold Lake, and Bonnyville will have the opportunity to learn Cree through a new course.

The course is funded through a \$50,000 grant provided by Alberta Education's Dual Credit Start Up Funding for Schools.

The board also approved the Cree Language and Culture pilot course for Grades 4 through 9 at Light of Christ Catholic School in Lac La Biche.
