Council of School Councils Committee

Lakeland Catholic has created a new platform for members of school councils to meet directly with board trustees. The Council of School Council Committee will be launched this year, with the intention of bringing the LCSD Board of Trustees and school council members from across the division together to collaborate, discuss common concerns, and engage in professional development.

“The Council of School Councils is an opportunity for school board trustees and members of school councils to engage throughout the year. During these meetings they are able to discuss issues relevant to their schools, their individual school councils, school councils across the division, as well as the board on a local and provincial level,” said Superintendent Pamela Guilbault.

Benefits of the committee include providing an opportunity for trustees to engage with schools councils three times per school year, while also creating a platform for discussion around specific areas of concern, collaborative conversations, and building and maintaining strong division-wide relationships.

The board made a motion to approve the committee, and are eager to meet with school councils at this capacity.

“Trustees are actively involved with their respective school councils currently, and attend meetings frequently. This is another layer that brings school council members from across the division together to share their common concerns and ideas, and build relationships with each other and our board,” said Guilbault.
