Award Presentation

Paola Corbi and Oksana Shevchenko from Action for Healthy Communities attended the regular board meeting and were presented with the Alberta School Board Association's Friends of Education Zone 2/3 Award. The organization was nominated for the award by Lakeland Catholic for their work within the division with newcomer families.

Paola thanked the board for the nomination, and said the organization is eager to continue to work with the division in providing programming to English Language Learner students and their families.

Official Enrollments

Superintendent Pamela Guilbault presented the division's official enrollments for the 2022-23 school year. Lakeland Catholic was just shy of predictions, with an official enrollment of 2,604 students across eight schools.

"When we look at the number of students in each school, we are pleased to say that five schools have met or exceeded the enrollment projections we initially submitted to the government in March 2022," Pamela said.

A breakdown of enrollment across the division:

École Notre Dame Elementary School: 272 (Grades 1-4)

Dr. Bernard Brosseau Middle School: 298 (Grades 5-8)

École Notre Dame High School: 413 (Grades 9-12)

Holy Cross Elementary School: 323 (Grades 1-6)

St. Dominic Elementary School: 245 (Grades 1-6)

Assumption Jr/Sr High School: 545 (Grades 7-12)

Holy Family Catholic School: 87 (Grades 1-12)

Light of Christ Catholic School: 230 (Grades 1-12)

The division has a "healthy pre-kindergarten program," described Pamela, with 133 preschool students enrolled so far this school year.

"This enrollment generally increases later in the year, which results in our schools opening more preschool classes after the Christmas break."
