Superintendent's Report - September 2022

Preparation for Meeting with Minister LaGrange

Throughout September, the division engaged with stakeholders ahead of a meeting with Alberta's Minister of Education Adriana LaGrange. Preparation involved advocacy and the creation of videos highlighting Lakeland Catholic's capital plans for the 2022- 23 school year, which includes replacement Kindergarten to Grade 12 schools in Waskatenau and Lac La Biche. The division obtained a letter of support from the Village of Waskatenau in our efforts to obtain a new facility in the community.

All of these steps are in alignment with Goal Three: Equity and Inclusion under the outcome students and staff will experience success through equitable and inclusive decision-making and system processes.

Organization and Management of Division Resources

Staffing continues to be a priority for Lakeland Catholic, with openings currently at Light of Christ, Dr. Bernard Brosseau, and Notre Dame Elementary.

Total enrollment as of September 30, 2022 is 2,604, 193 in Early Learning and 2,411 in Grades 1 through 12.

This is also in alignment with Goal 3: Equity and Inclusion.

Curriculum Implementation

One example of Goal 2: Student Success, is Lakeland Catholic's continued support for coordinators and directors as they implement professional development at a school-level regarding the new curriculum implementation for literacy, numeracy, and Physical Education and Wellness.
