Superintendent's Report - October 2022

Website Traffic

Lakeland Catholic has been utilizing the division website as a tool for communication with our community in numerous ways. Through photo galleries, news blogs, and new web pages, LCSD has kept families informed of ongoing activities and programs throughout our schools.

It is evident the community is staying actively informed on LCSD's happenings through our website analytics. In the reporter, between September 1, 2021 and September 30 2021, the division website had 8,066 page views. Within that same time frame this year, our website traffic has seen a 72 per cent increase with 19,431.

Council of School Councils

The Council of School Councils met on October 19 at St. Louis Parish Hall to discuss the responsibilities of the committee members, topics for shared advocacy, and share issues of school councils across the division.
