Transportation Update

Lakeland Catholic shared a communication with parents and guardians thanking them for their ongoing patience surrounding transportation. The letter clarified some of the recent issues regarding bus routes, which included a change in busing contractor.

The division has now contracted Avenir Bus Lines to provide busing for students in the Bonnyville and Cold Lake communities. Over the course of the past month, Lakeland Catholic has been working with Avenir to recruit drivers for the remaining open bus routes, with few left to fill as of January 12.

Communication has always been a priority for the division, and throughout the process, Lakeland Catholic has been sharing information with the community as it becomes available - updating impacted families quickly.
