Unique Scholarship

Lakeland Catholic student Sydney Greenlaw is excelling in her chosen field of study. The Assumption Jr/Sr High School student, who just graduated Grade 12 on May 27, will be participating in a unique scholarship opportunity. She is the first in northern Alberta to receive the Faculty of Science of the University of Ottawa Undergraduate Research Scholarship.

Through the \$11,500 scholarship, Greenlaw will work closely over the summer with one of the University of Ottawa's world-class research groups as a research assistant to one of the professors. She will have another opportunity to expand her research experience the following summer after completing her first year of her undergraduate program.

This is in alignment with Goal Two: Student Success, where students will benefit from innovative, relevant and alternative, experiential programming to ensure students are well prepared for work or further studies.
